Rules & Regulations

- Vendor registration begins at 9:00 AM for set-up and you must be ready for the public by 11:00 AM. You are required to stay until the end of the festival (11 AM – 5 PM).
- All items for sale must be of your own production – any size, any medium. Artwork must be “family friendly”; committee representatives reserve the right to remove work they deem non-compliant with requirements.
- Exhibitors must provide their own booth set-up and should be prepared for inclement weather. Tables, tents, tent weights, chairs, linens, and electricity are not provided.
- Booth assignments will be designated by the committee representatives and will be posted to the festival website prior to the event.
- This is a rain or shine event – please plan accordingly by bringing tents, tarps, or canopy. No refunds will be issued once accepted into the festival.
- Alcohol is not permitted.
- Your completed application and payment must be received before a decision can be made regarding your acceptance. The deadline for consideration is Friday, September 21st, 2018.
- You will be notified of acceptance status once your application has been juried. For vendors not accepted for placement, your full payment will be returned.
- No vendor shall leave the festival area, or begin to break down their displays during operating hours (11 AM – 5 PM) without written permission from the Festival Committee. Vendors must remove all items from the site no later than 6:30 PM on the day of the festival. Any expense incurred by the festival in removing any displays/trash from the vendor’s site shall be the financial responsibility of the vendor.
- Conduct: All vendors are responsible for the conduct and proper behavior of all personnel and volunteers working in the area.
- Acts of God: The festival shall have no liability what so ever for any damage to any person, matter, or thing resulting from storm, wind, water, fire, lightning, or other acts of God.
- Food Vendors: Must present a RI state vendor permit in addition to meeting any local licensing requirements. Any food vendors must arrive onsite no later than 10:00 AM.
