Food and Beverage Regulation

Clients are allowed to bring in their own already prepared food as well as non-alcoholic beverages. Kitchen appliances may be used for heating and cooling. Cooking on the premises is only allowed for the licensed and insured caterer. Client is able to choose the caterer/vendor of their choice, as long as the proper up-to-date license and insurance is submitted and approved prior to event.

There is a \$100 additional fee (non-refundable/non-transferrable) for use of the property dumpster. However, fee can be avoided by trash being removed off-site by either host/caterer.

Alcohol Regulation

The sale, service, and consumption of alcoholic beverages is strictly regulated by the Rhode Island State Liquor Control Board. The Overlook at Meehan requires *ALL alcohol must be brought in and served, by a "Class P or Class F/F-1" licensed, insured, and certified caterer or company*. By law, events with alcohol are limited to 5 hours of serving time. All liquor consumption must cease 30 minutes before the event ends.

Any individual that fails to comply with these regulations may result in being removed from the premises by the North Providence Police Department.

Video Surveillance

The Overlook at Meehan and all areas of Governor Notte Park, exterior/interior, are monitored by the North Providence Police Department thru video surveillance.

Contracted Vendors

Clients are responsible to ensure that all contracted vendors and performers act in accordance with all local and state laws, regulations and ordinances. The Overlook at Meehan shall not honor any demands or arrangements made for, or by, a third party unless written consent of client.

The client shall be held responsible for damage caused to park property by a contracted vendor or performer. Any items brought in, from a vendor, must be taken off-site at the end of the event.

Each vendors' names must be listed on the contract before final payment. Vendors must add "Town of North Providence, 2000 Smith St North Providence, RI 02911" as an additional insurer.

Liability and Damage Policy

Client shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Town of North Providence, its employees from and against any and all claims, suits, actions, or liabilities for injury or death of any person, or for loss or damage to property, which arises out of Clients use of Premises.

Rental Items

Any rental items brought in or picked up by any vendor, must be coordinated with the Overlook at Meehan Manager. Items may not be dropped off or picked up without the proper scheduled time.
